Section 2 : Health Hazard Data

Acute Health Effects: Active pharmaceutical ingredient. Exercise appropriate precautions to prevent overexposure via inhalation, or contact with the eyes. May cause irritation of mucus membranes. This compound has been shown to be teratogenic in laboratory test animals. Women who are or who may become pregnant should exercise caution when handling this material.

Section 3 : First Aid Measures
